Colorado Department of Labor and Employment

- <u>The Work Share Program</u> provides an alternative to laying off employees by allowing them to keep working, but with fewer hours. While an employee is working fewer hours, he or she may be eligible to collect part of his or her regular unemployment benefits.
- **<u>Rapid Response</u>** provides guidance and information for businesses facing corporate restructuring and downsizing.
